Tuition & Scholarship Info: All singers will receive an electronic invoice for their season tuitions.

- Tuition invoices will be emailed prior to September 9, 2025. Tuition payments can be made by visiting the online link on the automated tuition invoice or by contacting the LYC Office in person.

LYC Fundraising: All LYC singers have their tuition subsidized by LYC's fundraising efforts, meaning that the annual cost to participate is \$1,500 but only \$650 of that is passed on to the singers as a tuition fee so ALL singers receive financial assistance. Because of LYC's *No Song Unsung Scholarship Initiative*, the Board and Staff work diligently to assist with eliminating cost barriers to participation in LYC. To that end, LYC's Board of Directors traditionally hosts yearly fundraising event(s). We depend on donations and volunteers to make these event(s) happen!
